Staffordshire Commissioner's Office response to your enquiry is as follows:

I can confirm that the Staffordshire Commissioner's Office does/does not hold the requested information.

Please can you tell me who purchased the former Police Post that you recently sold on the Stone Road, Eccleshall, and how much the sale was for?

The former police post was purchased for £200,000

The purchaser is AJ Roe Properties Limited

Can you also give me the justification (decision as recorded) for not allowing the single community purchase bid that was submitted?

The Commissioner is restricted by law to accept the best value offer for any building. In respect of his policing and crime role; he does not have access to the powers conferred to local authorities and others by the Localism Act 2011. The community bid process was however, fully aligned with the 2012 Regulations that provide for assets of community value to be considered.
