Staffordshire Commissioner's Office response to your enquiry is as follows:

a) How much has been paid by the force to LQCs between the above dates for payment for their role as an LQC at police misconduct hearings please provide a total figure

b) How many LQCs are at the force's disposable as of the 28th of October 2022? Please also provide the name of the person

c) what has been the largest payment made to an LQC during the above period

2. How much has been paid by the force to Independent Panel Members between the above dates for payment for their role as Independent Panel Members at police misconduct hearings

b) How many Independent Panel Members are at the force's disposable as of the 28th of October 2022

c) what has been the largest payment made to an Independent Panel Member during the above period

I can confirm that the Staffordshire Commissioner does hold the information that you have requested.

Staffordshire Police does not pay for misconduct panel appointments for either LQCs or IPMs, this is paid for by the Police & Crime Commissioner directly, as they are both appointed, selected and assigned by the PCC. There have been no Misconduct Panels held during the period outlined that have required an LQC and an IPM.
