In doing so he puts forward precept proposals to the Police, Fire and Crime Panel which they are required to consider. Under the Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011, the Panel has the power to veto the precept proposals if they deem them too high or too low.

The Police, Fire and Crime Panel registered their support for the Police and Crime precept on 2nd February 2026. The proposal was for a 5.2% increase (£15) per annum, increasing the council tax to £302.57 per annum for a Band D property.

The Panel confirmed their support in reports to the Commissioner.
