

## ETAP FARS Meeting 23 September 2019

Item 2 (ii)

Since the July report, we have concentrated on following through the commitment made to undertake new thematics to take us to the end of the year. All the topics mentioned my last report have commenced, including for the first time a Thematic on the Fire and Rescue Service.

All fire and rescue services (FARS) must promote fire safety, including fire protection and the objective of this first Thematic is to review how FARS undertake their statutory duty to promote and enforce fire safety in the non-domestic premises in the county. This programme is known as Fire Protect.

Status of this review is as follows:

Fire Protect Programme	The DCTR and team leader held a meeting with the Director of Prevent and Protect on the 4 October following which the Terms of Reference were completed, approved and distributed. At the meeting, agreement was made to forward Policy documents and on receipt, the full team conducting the review will set up their first meeting. With holiday commitments this
