Freedom of Information request: reference SCO/FOI/015/2023 first notified to us by email on 10 May 2023

Staffordshire Commissioner's Office response to your enquiry is as follows:

Are you able to provide details for any funding that's has been provided from the Commissioner's office specifically for knife crime interventions and youth violence in East Staffordshire and who this funding went to?

Clarification was sought and the timescale for the above request was for a timeframe of 24 months.

I can confirm that the Staffordshire Commissioner does hold the information that you have requested.

Burton Albion Community Trust £4990

The Commissioner's office award annual funding from its Locality Deal Fund to Community Safety Partnerships (CSP's) for each local authority area in Staffordshire. It is then for the CSP's to determine how they fund local initiatives which is dependent on their local priorities.

Whilst the Commissioner's office has not awarded funding directly to East Staffordshire, other than the detail above, there are many pan Staffordshire initiatives taking place. One of those initiatives which is commissioned by the Commissioner's office, delivers a service to those at risk of violence and Child Criminal Exploitation (CCE), which includes A&E and Custody Navigator and 121 support and targeted education.

If you are dissatisfied with the handling of your request, you have the right to ask for an internal review. Internal review requests should be submitted within two months of the date of receipt of this email and should be addressed to:
