Supporting victims of stalking is not a standalone service. It forms part of our Victim Gateway Service, which is our front door service for victims of crime. It includes a triage function, signposting to specialist services and practical and emotional support for victims of crime. The full cost of the service has not been included as it cannot be portioned out for stalking alone.

Citizens Advice Bureau

4. Services provided

Signposting, advice, guidance, information, practical & emotional support

5. Specific stalking outcome

Because the service supports victims of a range of crime types they use the 'Victim of Crime Outcome Star', therefore not a specific stalking outcome tool.
