Freedom of Information request: reference SCO/FOI/23/2021, first notified to us by email on the 07 June 2021.

Staffordshire Commissioner's Office response to your enquiry is as follows:

I can confirm that the Staffordshire Commissioner's Office does hold the requested information.

I can see from my Council Tax Bill the Borough Council collects Staffordshire Commissioner (Police and Crime) an increase of 6 % over last year and paid £238.57, Staffordshire Commissioner (Fire & Rescue) an increase of 2 % over last year and paid £78.78.

I'm looking for the following information.

1) Total POLICE funding for the Stone area (ST15) including Council Tax, Government Grants for the population of Stone.

There is no specific funding separately allocated for the ST15 post code, which would fall under Stafford Borough. However, I can confirm that the total revenue budget and funding for the Staffordshire Commissioner (covering the Staffordshire and Stoke on Trent area) for 2021/22 is £222 million.

- 2) The amount received for the sale of Stone Police Station to developers into dwellings. $\pm 550,000$
- 3) Payment from Police to Town/Borough Council for hosting Police Station in Granville Terrace Council Building in Stone.

For the period 2020/21 the rental figure was \pm 20,900
